VIEW FROM THE EYRIE

Rather a quiet season with not much movement and no really significant developments. I forecast that 1909 will decide whether Italy is going to try for a win or settle for a draw.

Now that the endgame is here, it is clear that Italy can take Ank, Run, Sev, Tun without much difficulty. If Italy wants the win, this means that three more centres are needed, and this task will not be quite so easy. French Mun can be easily held by England against Italy (or by Italy against England for that matter) so it seems that if we are to see an Italian win then he must move against either the War/Mos/Stp group, or the Mar/Spa/Por group, or perhaps both. A tough proposition.

Looking at the position I can't see any benefit in England moving against France; the time has passed. Any such attack would almost certainly mean victory for Italy.

So, Italy has some decisions to make - although he may well have taken them already! Does he attack Russia with whom he seems to have some form of understanding? Does he move in force on France? Or does he accept the draw that is on offer?

We shall see.
