Avalon Hill Takeover. Briefly mentioned last time, more information on AH's plans for the future is now becoming available. ((NGC COMMITTEE PLEASE READ THIS)) The main effect over here is that the NGC's monopoly of the flyers in the boxes is likely to cease and Avalon Hill will be setting up a new Novice Entrance Project to be run by the IDA on an open-to-all basis - a few apologetic words from some Committee members might be in order if they want the NGC to derive full benefit from this. Other changes are likely to be small; the board itself will be slightly modified to fit a bookcase format but the rules will scarcely be touched. One other little point is that AH have apparently no objections to the publishing of variants and their sale, though they do ask that designers refrain from direct retail sales to retail outlets and professional packaging, which seems reasonable. I don't know what is to happen to Phylmar's licence though I suspect it will be gradually withdrawn. More news as it comes. ((info taken from Council Courier)).
