

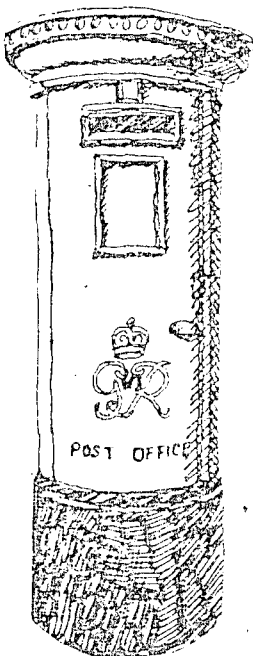

POSTAGE I think the easiest way for you to pay the cost of sending PIGMY to you is to include a first class stamp with your orders, but with your first set of orders you should include 3 stamps, one for this issue, one for the next issue, and one to cover you in the event of an NMR, okay? (if you've already paid for this issue just send 2 stamps)

DEADLINE The result of the deadline vote was an overwhelming demand for a 3 week deadline, apologies to those who wanted it every 4 weeks. It's a long deadline this time as this is the first season.

STANDBYES I have arranged for a standby player to follow this game, then if one of you NMR's the standby will send in some orders for the country concerned. If that player NMR's the following move the standby orders will be used and the standby player will be given complete control of that country. I'm not using standbys for the sake of using them,

the trouble is that this game is free so there's no deterrent to prevent dropouts - not that any of you are going to drop out, are you!

CONTRIBUTIONS As this zine is so small press and letters are not asked for, they are DEMANDED (in the nicest possible way). It goes without saying that you should inform me of any address changes. This is the first time I've published a zine so I would welcome any suggestions as to how I could improve things. Any articles etc. will always be welcome.
