Rome: After the recent stabbing of the Russian ambassador, Luigi our loyal and devoted servant decided to repeat this action.

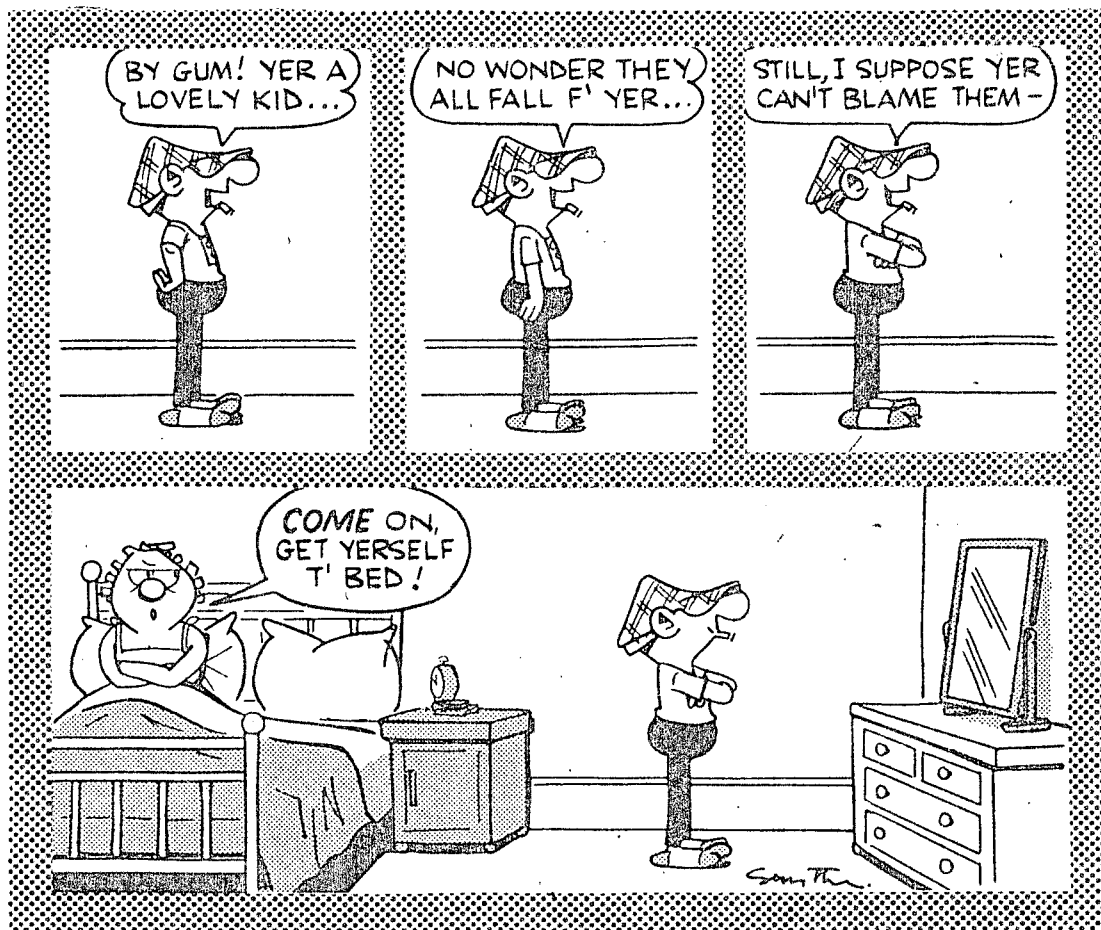
